

Timecard and Tracking during Midnattssolsrallyt 2026

During the competition, you will be using the electronic timecard—the mobile app **Resultatservice Tidkort**—to manage certain TCs (Time Controls), such as arrival TCs, the final finish, etc. Primarily, this allows the organizer to reduce the need for officials.

Before the Competition

- **Download and Install:** Before the competition, download and install the timecard app on your phones.
- **GPS Permissions:** You must allow the app to use GPS with the highest possible accuracy.
- **Test Logging In:** Test that you can log into the app using your account—either the same one you used for registration or the co-driver's account. To log in, you must have an account with Resultatservice, and your account must be specified in your registration.

Your Account

The account name (email address) is specified in the first part of the registration. The app is available for download from:

- **Android:** Google Play Store
- **iPhone:** Apple App Store

Test at Home

There will be a test competition available so that you can try out the timecard app at home before the rally.

During the Competition

- **Checking in at a TC:** You check in at a TC by scanning the QR code sign using the timecard app at your correct departure or arrival time.
- **Important Regarding Scanning:** Scanning the QR code must be done using the timecard app, **not** your regular camera function.
- **Calculation of Road Section Times:** The timecard app helps you calculate road section

times, etc. Stage times will automatically appear in the app after you have finished a stage (press the Refresh button).

Tracking / GPS

The same app that handles the timecard also includes a tracking function (GPS). The tracking function has two modes:

1. **Road Section (Transport):** In road section mode, you use the app as a timecard with road section times. The tracking function then runs in the background and sends your location information to the rally HQ.
2. **Special Stage / Competition Mode:** Once you have registered your arrival at the TC for a Special Stage (SS), the timecard app switches to competition mode, enabling various alarm functions, etc.

Starting a Special Stage (SS)

Starting an SS is done by driving up to the start line and starting at your preliminary time shown in the timecard, or at the time assigned by the TC staff.

Power and Mounting of the Phone

The phone consumes extra power when using GPS.

- **Charging:** Ensure you have a way to charge the phone inside the rally car! Bring an extra power bank or have a permanent power supply connected to the phone.
- **GPS Settings:** You must have GPS activated on your phone with the highest possible accuracy.
- **Mounting:** Place the phone in a mount so that you can see and reach it during the special stages, and ensure it has good mobile and GPS reception.
